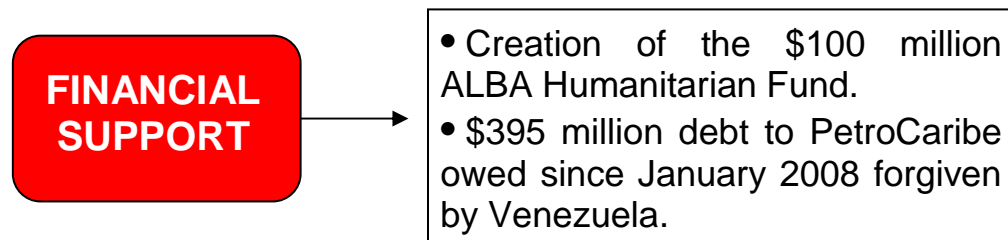


VENEZUELAN ASSISTANCE SENT TO HAITI AFTER THE EARTHQUAKE

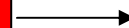

ENERGY



- Continuation of the supply of petroleum to Haiti under the provisions of PetroCaribe agreement.
- Donation of fuel for Haitian medical centers (16,100 gallons).
- Delivery of more than 240 GWh since November 2008.
- Technical evaluation for the location of portable electricity-generating stations.

EDUCATION



- Training of 300 Haitian medical students in Cuba and 70 in Venezuela.
- Continuation of Literacy Plan in humanitarian camps.
- Education of Haitian students in short-term career programs (200) and vocational programs (2,000).

**AGRICULTURE
AND FOOD
INITIATIVES**



- ALBA agricultural mission “On the Land.”
- Donation of seeds and equipment, construction of artificial lakes, creation of agro-ecology technical schools, etc.
- Distribution of 70 tons of corn seeds, 50 tons to farmers and 20 tons to Haitian government.

PORTABLE PLANTS

- Construction of 10 water wells coordinated with the NGO Food for the Poor.
- Construction of two underground water tanks of 96,000 Liters for the storage of water.
- Installation of seven portable water plants and the ability to install 30 more.

- Pilot program for a census in humanitarian camps.
- Training of 300 facilitators for the Psycho-Social Reconstruction workshop.
- Outline of work plans with Haitian Ministry of Women's Affairs.
- Evaluation of lands for the relocation of camps.
- Instruction of camp leaders in self-defense, First Aid and risk assessment.
